

# BCRP Confirmation Components 1, 2 & 3

- This form is to be completed by a Building Contract Review Program (BCRP) Service Provider where a Builder has elected to participate in the BCRP for a building contract of \$50,000 or more.
- Completion of this document should be undertaken when confirming that the participating Builder has successfully completed the following 3 components of the BCRP:
  - BCRP Component 1 Contract Document Review.
  - BCRP Component 2 Reasonableness of Budget & Progress Payments
  - BCRP Component 3 Builder Performance Review Schedule
- The completed form should be forwarded to the Scheme Agent and the Builder's Broker for attachment to the Project Application.

- 1. Site visits require attendance at the project site by the BCRP service provider.
- 2. Remote site assessments do not require attendance at the project site by the BCRP service provider. The service provider must review sufficient information and make necessary enquiries to meet the requirements of Component 4 - Builder Performance Review. For example, the completion of the remote site assessment can include a review of photographs of the project or relevant documentation and telephone enquiries with the Builder.
- 3. Site visits and remote site assessments should not reflect the mandatory certification dates; rather they should be determined based on the specific project and the requirements under Component 4 of the BCRP.
